Little Summer Saints Day Camp	Little Summer Saints is back for another fantastic summer- filled with fun and surprises! Our youngest campers will get to know our amazing campus and all it has to offer. Our rising PreK campers will engage in age-appropriate activities that will have them begging to return the following day. They will have a chance to participate in activities including our arts and crafts program, as well as, learning cooperative games in the gym and on the field. Each week they will participate in two camp favorites: Water Day and Carnival Day! We have a fantastic line-up of counselors who are ready to lead the fun. <b>*Little Summer Saints Day Camp is only open to children who will be entering the St. Mary's PreK program in the Fall of 2025.</b>
<b>June Volleyball Clinics</b>	
Serve Receive and Attacking Clinic	This session will focus on the technical aspects of serve receive, including work on: perfecting platform, short and long distances, different platform angles for different serves along the court, shoulder movements when serving to our lateral sides, identifying the speed and distance of the serve with first steps and communication. We will also focus on the technical aspects of attacking, including work on: arm swings, hand contact, approach, spot hitting, footwork, timing.
Defense and Setting Clinic	This session will focus on the technical aspects of defense, including work on: loading (split step), fast first step to ball (forward vs lateral movements), angles and collapsing of the platform depending on the speed on the attack, every ball is playable, footwork from base to down. We will also focus on the technical aspects of setting, including work on: teaching the position, the responsibility and the skills of having the second ball, footwork to perfect pass, off pass, wide side and short side, body and hands positions (start point - contact - end point).
Blocking, Serving and Attacking Clinic	This session will focus on the basic technical aspects of blocking including: footwork, half moon technique, timing, owning the net. We will also focus on perfecting the serving skill, including work on: perfect toss, hand contact and end point for locations, correct steps when jump serving. We will add some attacking work in this session.
All Skills Clinic	During this session we will focus on improving all aspects of your volleyball skills with the goal of helping you become a versatile volleyball player. We will add multiple different skill drills to implement the aspects learned. Coaches will break down the fundamentals of these skills with a detailed practice plan.

Babysitting 101	Interested in babysitting? Students will receive an introduction to basic care, safety, and first aid for infants and children, learn about the developmental stages of infants through school-age children, and design activities to use with each age group. Future babysitters will create age-appropriate meal-plans by learning about proper health and nutrition. Students will have hands-on experiences learning and practicing how to deliver aid in emergency situations including: CPR, the Heimlich maneuver, how to use an EpiPen, and how to provide basic first aid in the event of an injury. To conclude the program, students will design a babysitting advertisement for their business and receive a certificate of completion. The program can also be used to earn the Girl Scouts babysitting badge. <b>Take-home items include:</b> Little Medical School student first aid kit, student-made activities, reusable information sheet for babysitting, course completion certificate
Cheer/Swiftie	Get ready to cheer, dance, and sing with your favorite Swiftie squad! Little Artists Summer Camp	Calling all little hands and big imaginations! Our Little Artists Summer Camp is the perfect place for your child to dive into the colorful world of art. Designed especially for Pre-K and Kindergarteners, this camp will encourage creativity, exploration, and self-expression through fun, hands-on art activities.
Little Doctor School	Through hands-on activities and role-plays, students will take on the role of a doctor and learn about the vital organs and systems that make up the human body. Throughout the week, participants will become different medical professionals by specializing in and exploring new body systems. Students will engage in role-plays and create models of parts of the body to learn how they work and what doctors do to prevent, diagnose, and treat illnesses. These future doctors will practice using real medical tools including a stethoscope and reflex hammer. This camp includes many daily take-home items and products the students will use and create as part of the hands-on activities. At the end of the week, families are invited to attend a ceremony where the campers will demonstrate their new skills and graduate with their own student lab coat, stethoscope, and diploma. <b>Take-home items include:</b> student lab coat; stethoscope; heart, lung, and digestion models; organ sticker set; student-made bone and blood models; brain hat; graduation certificate.
Little Vet School: Adopt a Cat (Full Day)	After adopting their very own plush cat, students will take on the role of a veterinarian and learn how to care for their new feline friend. These future veterinarians will role-play a cat's first visit to the clinic by appropriately approaching the cat by studying their body language, learning how to give a body condition score, and finishing the appointment with a whiskers-to-tail exam. Camp participants will study a cat's vital organs to learn about common cat illnesses. Through role-plays, students will treat a sick and injured cat patient, understand how to reduce cat stress, and maintain a proper living environment to keep their cat happy and healthy. This camp includes many daily take-home items and products the students will use and create as part of the hands-on activities. At the end of the week, families are invited to attend a ceremony where the campers will demonstrate their new skills and graduate with their own student lab coat, plush cat, and diploma. <b>Take-home items include:</b> student lab coat; plush cat; cat carrier and vet clinic designs; veterinarian journal; kitty litter box; student-made cat toy; blood model; adoption and graduation certificates.

Little Vet School: Adopt a Dog	After adopting their very own plush dog, students will take on the role of a veterinarian through hands-on activities and role-plays. These future veterinarians will perform a nose to-tail exam, learn about proper hydration and nutrition, and practice giving vaccinations. Camp participants will study a dog's vital organs and learn how to perform an X-ray. Students will diagnose and treat a sick and injured dog and role-play the key responsibilities within a vet clinic. This camp includes many daily take-home items and products the students will use and create as part of the hands-on activities. At the end of the week, families are invited to attend a ceremony where the campers will demonstrate their new skills and graduate with their own student lab coat, plush dog, and diploma. <b>Take-home items include:</b> student lab coat; plush dog; veterinarian journal; vet clinic design; healthy dog treat recipe card and playdough treats; dog bowl; tick demonstration; syringe; dog eye model; adoption and graduation certificates
Mindful Meditation & Expression	Mindful Movement & Expression will help your child calm & focus their mind, strengthen their body & find joy through movement. We'll have fun engaging in journaling, mindful centers, yoga postures, partner work, games & crafts!
3D Printing	Nexplore 3D Printing Start+ empowers students to bring their imaginations into reality with 3Doodler pens. Each lesson combines a structured STEAM project with wiggle room to doodle, explore, and create their own ideas. Students might construct landforms to learn about geography or use geometry to make their own shapeshifters. Nexplore 3D Printing Start+ transforms STEM concepts into 3D projects and sparks joy as students watch science come to life.
PreK Primer	Pre-K primer gives our incoming Saints an advantage of practicing the fundamentals of pre-K while familiarizing students with the school, classroom and daily routines. We will learn the basics of pre-K skills including fine motor, gross motor, communication, as well as the fundamentals of writing, reading & math. <b>This camp is all about FUN learning &amp; confidence boosting!</b>
